Welcome to the 7th Beverley Puppet Festival! Originally just 5 companies in 2005 and biennial since 2006, the last festival in 2014 won a Remarkable East Yorkshire Tourism Award, attracting audience numbers close to 9,000. The team want to heartily thank all the volunteers, funders, sponsors, partners, artists, venues and audiences who have built this event to what it is now.

Constantly striving to open up new worlds through the spectrum of puppetry in all its diversity, from emerging artists to experienced puppet masters, the festival takes pride in its role as a forum for artistic exchange for both professional puppeteers and unsuspecting audiences!

2016 sees shows for all ages, which span binding themes of mythical creatures, strange beasts, humanity's inner journeys and the challenging of superficial appearances. 30 companies, with only 3 from overseas, create the largest festival in the world to focus mainly on British puppetry. Its timing over three days in one friendly location is increasingly recognised as a valuable opportunity for the puppetry sector to network, showcase itself and grow.

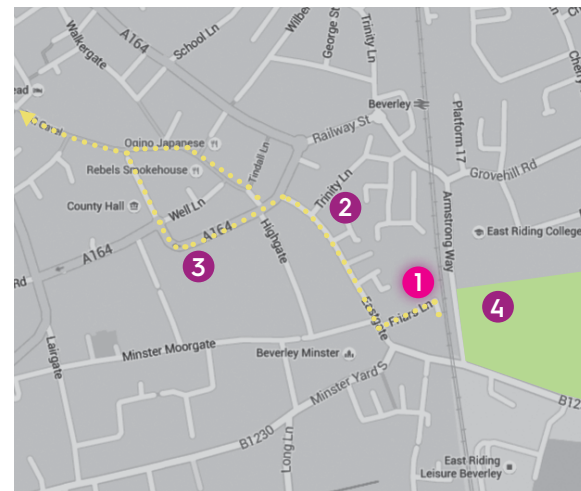
